- _____ 1) **AllPro Radon Services Company** has approval to perform radon testing of this dwelling.
- _____ 2) EPA "closed-building conditions" were established at least 12 hours prior to testing. (All exterior windows and doors are required to be shut. Doors may be opened briefly for normal entry and exit. Whole-house and window fans should not be operating. Window A/C units may be operated in recirculation mode. Fireplace dampers, if present are shut unless they are the primary sources of heat.)
- _____ 3) The HVAC system is operating in normal automatic mode. Forced air units are not to be operated continuously, unless that is the normal mode of operation.
- _____ 4) If applicable, the radon mitigation system has been operating for 24 hours prior to the radon test and will remain operating normally throughout testing.
- _____ 5) The responsible individual agrees not to move or interfere with the detectors or have its performance altered during the radon survey. (Examples of performance alteration would be covering the detector, moving it to another location or opening the windows during the short-term test)
- _____ 6) **AllPro Radon Services Company** has approval to install test controls. The devices are a form of quality control and are intended to prevent test interference.

NOTICE

The Radon Certification Act requires that anyone who provides any radon-related service or product to the general public must be certified by the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection. You are entitled to evidence of certification from any person who provides such services or products. You are also entitled to a price list of services or products offered. All radon measurement data will be sent to the Department as required in the Act and will be kept confidential.
